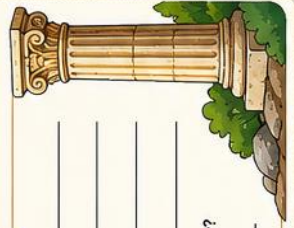

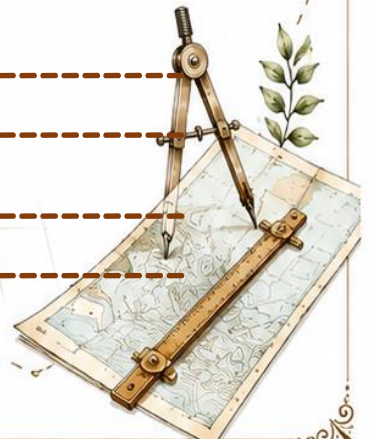

Great Wall of China	Beijing	Longest man-made defensive wall
Taj Mahal	New Delhi	White marble mausoleum built by Shah Jahan
Eiffel Tower	Paris	Iconic iron tower and symbol of France
Statue of Liberty	Washington, D.C.*	Gift from France and symbol of freedom (<i>located in New York City</i>)
Christ the Redeemer	Brasília*	Giant statue overlooking Rio de Janeiro (<i>located in Rio de Janeiro</i>)
Pyramids of Giza	Cairo	Ancient Egyptian pyramids
Colosseum	Rome	Roman amphitheatre
Sydney Opera House	Canberra*	Famous performing arts venue (<i>located in Sydney</i>)
Machu Picchu	Lima	Ancient Inca citadel
Petra	Amman	Rock-carved ancient city
