Answer Key:

- Greenland: $(2,166,086 \text{ km}^2)$ $(836,330 \text{ sq miles})$ - Located in the North Atlantic and Arctic Oceans, it is the largest island on Earth.
- New Guinea: $(821,400 \text{ km}^2)$ $(317,150 \text{ sq miles})$ - Located in the southwestern Pacific Ocean, this island is split between Indonesia and Papua New Guinea.
- Borneo: $(748,168 \text{ km}^2)$ $(288,869 \text{ sq miles})$ - Located in Southeast Asia and shared by Indonesia, Malaysia, and Brunei.
- Madagascar: $(587,295 \text{ km}^2)$ $(226,756 \text{ sq miles})$ - Situated in the Indian Ocean, it is the largest island that forms a single country.
- Baffin Island: $(507,451 \text{ km}^2)$ $(195,928 \text{ sq miles})$ - Located in the Canadian Arctic, it is Canada's largest island and the fifth largest in the world
